

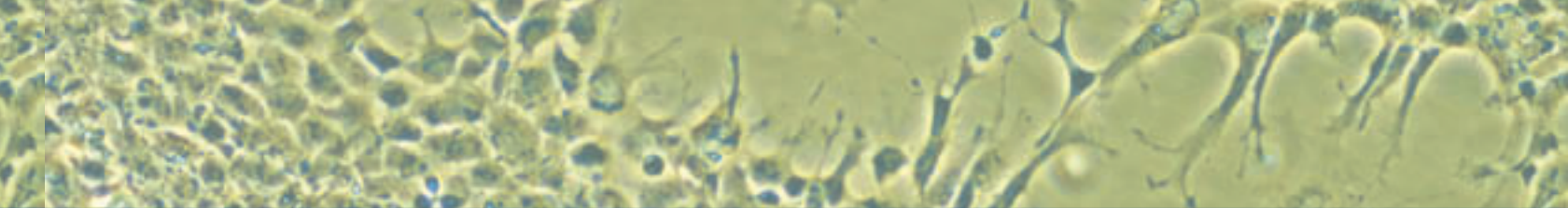

**1932–2005**



**T**he Cancer Research Center lost a great friend and supporter when Hartley Garrard Banks, Jr., passed away on Sunday, Nov. 20, 2005. Hartley had been diagnosed with heart disease earlier in the year. His last public appearance was at the Cancer Research Center Appreciation Reception on Thursday, Nov. 17. He visited with many lifelong friends and thoroughly enjoyed himself.

Hartley was the retired president of First Bank of Commerce (now Bank of America). He was an investor and real estate developer. As a banker, Hartley made loans critical to the economic growth of Columbia. He knew Columbia, understood its potential, and was willing to back those who shared his vision. Hartley had been a dedicated member of the CRC Board of Trustees from 1973 until his death. He served as secretary from 1975 to 1984; vice president in 1985 and 1986; and president from 1987 to 1995. During his term as president, Hartley helped finance our move to the present location on Berrywood Dr. He and his wife Nancy have helped sponsor the CRC Gala continuously since 1995. The 2006 Gala will be dedicated to his memory.

Hartley was a lifelong resident of Columbia, born here July 31, 1932. After graduating from Hickman High School in 1950, he attended the University of Missouri and earned a bachelor's degree in business and public administration. In 1954 he was commissioned a second lieutenant in the U.S. Army. He was assigned to the artillery and spent his first tour with the VIII Corps in Germany. At his father's request, Hartley left the army and returned to the "family business." Hartley never lost his love and respect for the military and stayed in the United States Army Reserve. He retired with the rank of lieutenant colonel after twenty years in the Reserves.

Fellow CRC trustee and longtime friend Lee Freese said, "Hartley was a very kind man. He and my late husband Ray, were close friends. I knew I could always depend on him for help if needed. He will truly be missed." The Cancer Research Center's Board of Trustees extends its deepest sympathy to the Banks family.

# IN HONOR OF DUKE

*Duke Kidwell was the guest of honor at the 2005 Gala, and he died on July 11, just days after the event. The CRC extends deepest gratitude and condolences to his family. The following contains excerpts from Marnie Tutt's letter in the event program.*

**T**onight we honor one of our own. Donald (Duke) Kidwell has been a member of the Board of Trustees, a Gala planning committee member, a generous financial contributor, and an enthusiastic supporter of the Cancer Research Center for over 15 years. Tonight, surrounded by family and friends, he is an example of what a committed member of this community can do to help others in the fight against cancer.

Duke grew up just south of here in Deer Park. He was born in 1932 to Marie and Pat Kidwell, the second of eight children. His was a loving home which encouraged hard work, self-discipline, and responsibility to family, community, and nation.

He knows nearly everyone in Boone County, and has made many lifelong friends who respect his sense of humor, work ethic, and moral character. Duke never lost the down-home touch, the connection to his roots, and the community in which he was raised. Indeed, except for his time in the service, Duke was never out of Missouri.

After graduating from Hickman High School in 1952, Duke joined the U.S. Marine Corps. He fought in Korea until the armistice was signed in 1953 and spent the rest of his enlistment on bases in Japan and Okinawa. Duke returned home and married the former Juanita Fite of Columbia in 1959. Their daughter

ter Brenda was born in September 1960 and they have a granddaughter, Andi.

Many of you who attended school here met Duke when he managed the liquor store at Eastgate IGA. Fred Parry met Duke there when he was attending Mizzou and they became friends. It was then that Duke began his association with the CRC. Duke's younger brother Jim worked for Ray Freese and Howard Eiffert at Boone County Lumber Co. He was a great supporter of this Gala and always sold over 200 tickets each year.

Sadly, Jim passed away from cancer in 1990. Another Kidwell brother, Bob, fought his own battle with cancer. Bob, who lived in South Carolina, was diagnosed with lung cancer shortly before the Gala (Bob died Monday, June 27, 2005). Let us honor Duke, remember Jimmy and Bob and resolve to do everything possible to support the work of the CRC.

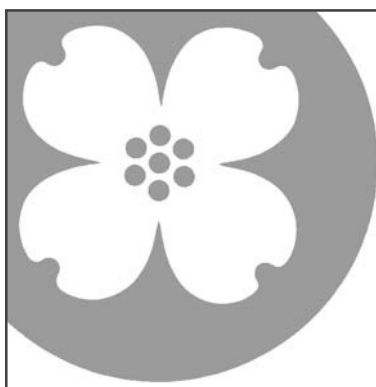

# CRC Community Outreach

## Education Mission

*“My work in Dr. Eisenstark’s laboratory was an exceptional introduction to the biological laboratory setting...”*

The Cancer Research Center, in conjunction with its research mission, engages students in order to enhance their scientific backgrounds. There are several support categories, depending upon other academic arrangements.

1. Students can gain experience at CRC while earning undergraduate credit at UMC or other local colleges. Students are assigned a semester project. For each hour of credit, the student is expected to be in the laboratory approximately three hours per week. A term paper is submitted at the end of the semester. Since it may be necessary to have a car, CRC provides \$100 compensation for each of four months per semester.

For additional compensation, students are encouraged to apply for scholarship funds. UMC students should contact Linda Blockus, Tucker Hall. Preference is given to students who have applied for scholarship funds.

If an arrangement is made to have the student work additional hours in the laboratory, the student is compensated \$8 per hour for the additional hours.

2. If a student desires an intern arrangement without college credit, CRC has limited scholarship funds for this. The student should submit a resume to the CRC’s Research Director, including a list of college science courses. The stipend for this type of internship is usually \$800 for the semester. Again, preference is given to students who have applied for scholarship funds.

3. As grants are obtained, CRC may employ technicians who have backgrounds in Microbiology and Biochemistry.

4. CRC also welcomes graduate students to perform rotations in our laboratory. In such cases, since it will be necessary to have a car, CRC will provide \$100 compensation for each of four months per semester.

# Sharyn Parks

*McCluer High School  
Florissant, Missouri*

Sharyn Parks worked at the CRC during the 1997–1998 academic year. She was a Director's Fund Scholar and spent about 390 laboratory hours here. Under the direction of Dr. Eisenstark, she studied how a cell can emerge from a resting stage into rapid growth. Her approach was to examine resting bacterial cells that had been stored, undisturbed, in tubes for four decades. These bacterial cells have a "survival" gene that protects cells during dormancy. Sharyn examined mutations in this important gene that alter the cell's ability to survive. The McCluer High School graduate did basic biological research looking for answers to questions such as which genes determine which cells will grow rapidly or will die. Sharyn presented her research at the Missouri Academy of Science.

Sharyn graduated from Mizzou with BS Honors in Biology and then worked as an analytical chemist at Sigma Chemical Company in St. Louis. She says, "My lab experience at CRC certainly came in handy." In August 2000, she began a Masters of Public Health in Epidemiology at St. Louis University. She was one of six students selected for a CDC-funded Eliminating Health Disparities Traineeship.

After receiving her MPH in May 2002, Sharyn moved to Atlanta, Ga. There she took a position with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, at the National Center for Injury Prevention and Control. She worked in the Center's Office of the Director as the human subjects coordinator. She was responsible for review, approval, and monitoring of all intramural and extramural research funded/conducted by the center. She moved on to the University of Pittsburgh in 2004 to begin her doctoral study.

Sharyn is presently in the second year of the Psychiatric Epidemiology program at the

Graduate School of Public Health and intends to conduct dissertation research regarding intimate partner violence as a long-term consequence of childhood maltreatment.

Sharyn Parks has come a long way since conducting research at CRC. She wrote, "I think it was during my time at CRC that I became aware of this whole other realm of cancer prevention research within the field of public health. If it wasn't made clear before, I want to say thank you again to everyone at CRC who helped in my training and development as an undergrad. It was an experience that I value to this day."

## Michelle Lewis

Michelle Lewis graduated in 1993 from Rock Bridge High School and in 1997 from St. Olaf College in Northfield, MN. She received her PhD from Washington University in St. Louis in 2003. Michelle completed two years of postdoctoral work at Auburn University, Auburn, Ala., finishing in 2005.

During the summer of 1995, Michelle worked at the Cancer Research Center. She was a Lorene Hofheins Scholar and

worked under the direction of Dr. Michael Calcutt. Her project was studying the response of cells to oxidative stress. Oxidative stress is induced in cells, making them more susceptible to DNA and protein damage. This type of damage can lead to cancer. Michelle presented her results at the PEW Midwest annual undergraduate seminars at Washington University Medical School, September 1995. Her research at CRC resulted in a published scientific paper.

Michelle's time at the CRC brings back pleasant memories. She says, "My experience at the CRC was wonderful, it gave me a



love for science and the process of discovery which lead me to decide on getting a PhD."

## Breca Starr Tracy

Breca Starr Tracy, from Ada, OK, graduated from high school in 1998 and attended Stephens College in Columbia, MO, graduating in 2002 with a degree in Biology and Health Sciences. At that time, Breca was accepted into the Doctoral program in Biological Chemistry at the University of Oklahoma's Medical School.

In 2000, Breca was awarded a Director's Scholarship from the Cancer Research Center. This outstanding program helps support top students who work



alongside experienced scientists at the CRC. Dr. Kelly Edwards, a Ray Freese Fellow and CRC Senior Scientist, supervised Tracy's cancer research. According to Dr. Edwards, "This type of scholarship is not only invaluable to CRC and the cancer

research we are performing, but it also assists our students with their career goals. Breca's internship at CRC clearly provided [her with] opportunity [...]." Breca is the senior author of a scientific paper that describes her CRC research.

Breca is grateful for the help she received from the CRC. She said, "I am thankful for the opportunities that CRC provided me. Breca expects to finish her PhD in June of 2006. She would like to stay in research and hopes to find a postdoctoral position at a major cancer research facility.

studying the effects of long-term starvation of cells. She also studied the susceptibility of cells to infection by bacteriophage as a means of molecular subtyping. Michelle's cancer research was supervised by Dr. Kelly Edwards, CRC Senior Scientist.

Cathy graduated from Jefferson City High in 1984. She attended Kansas State University from 1989–1990, Kansas University from 1990–1991, and the University of Missouri her final year, graduating in 1992 with a BS in Microbiology. While at UMC, Cathy began a two-year stint at the CRC. She then began graduate school in the Department of Microbiology and Molecular Genetics at the University of Missouri Medical School. Her CRC research resulted in a published scientific paper. Cathy studied the role of the NS2 protein in parvovirus replication. She authored two first-author publications and defended her thesis in July 2001.

In October of 2001, Cathy began a postdoctoral fellowship at Harvard Medical School, working on the assembly and function of viral factories in reovirus-infected cells. During her fellowship,

Cathy obtained four grants. While there, she authored two first-author manuscripts and was an associate author on four other manuscripts. In addition, she received an institutional National Research Scholars Award (NRSA) from the Harvard Infectious Disease program, and last year she wrote and received a two-year

individual NRSA. Cathy recently wrote and received a K22 early career development award to support her transition to faculty. She is currently interviewing for an assistant professor position at universities in the Midwest.

Cathy remembers her experience at the CRC as a time of great personal growth. She studied bacterial genes required for recovery and survival following near ultraviolet radiation in stationary phase, in particular the role of the *rpoS* protein in transcriptional regulation of HP1 catalase. She reports it was her first experience in a real research laboratory. She tells us the time spent at the CRC was literally a turning point in her life.

According to her K22 award, "My work in Dr. Eisenstark's laboratory was an exceptional introduction to the biological laboratory setting in which I learned both basic microbiological and molecular biology techniques, and more importantly, that working ... with a group of talented scientists to study basic scientific questions was precisely what I wanted to do with my life."

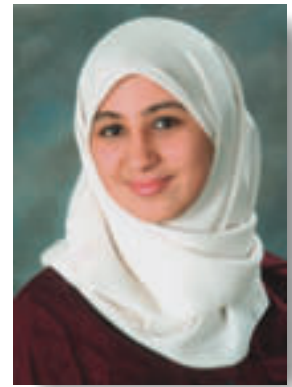

helping her mother through four separate battles with the disease, Sigholtz found that the CRC's work hit close to home. "It [cancer] affects us all, and this is a great way to get involved," she said.

Through solicitation for the annual CRC gala, Sigholtz enlisted the support of the St. Louis Rams and St. Louis Cardinals, which resulted in large donations for the cause.

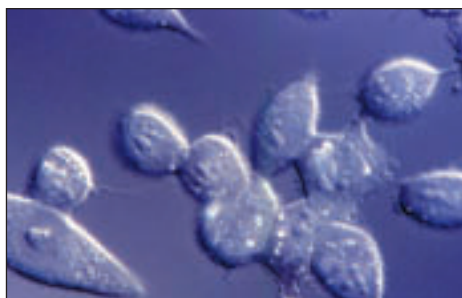

## Naturally Mellowed Typhimurium:

**P**rostate cancer is associated with aging and occurs in a latent or clinical form in 30-40% of men by age 40-50, increasing substantially in men over 50 years of age. Prostate cancer mortality in men is now second only to lung cancer, and as life expectancy increase so will the number of men affected. While hormone therapy is often effective during the initial stages of cancer development, most men develop hormone resistant cancer stages within two years after onset of the disease. This is why the first-line cancer treatment, chemotherapy utilizing taxol has met with only partial success. Many

patients develop taxol resistance and alternative treatments and new approaches are needed to arrest tumor cell growth. Recently, a genetically engineered non-toxic *Salmonella enterica* serovar Typhimurium strain (VNP20009) has been developed that preferentially infects and replicates within tumor cells achieving tumor to normal cell ratios exceeding 1000:1 while not causing the broad toxic effects normally associated with *Salmonella* strains found in nature.

However, there is still much work to be done. The delicate balance between optimal tumor killing ability and minimal toxicity to patient is still being perfected. Recently clinical trials of VNP were postponed due to unacceptable toxicity. The Cancer Research Center has a unique opportunity to achieve the balance necessary to turn *Salmonella* into a dedicated yet gentle cancer killer. Our laboratory has a reservoir of several thousand Typhimurium samples that differ from each other genetically. These strains have been stored at room temperature for better

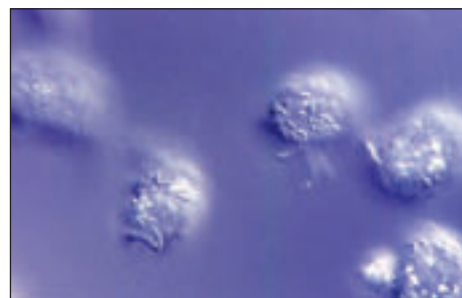
than 40 years and have naturally mellowed into non-toxic strains with natural tumor targeting talent. We are currently very excited about our strain 1674, which has exhibited the ability to attach strongly to prostate tumor cells (and

### PC-3M prostate cancer cells incubated with Typhimurium strain 1674 for 3 hours

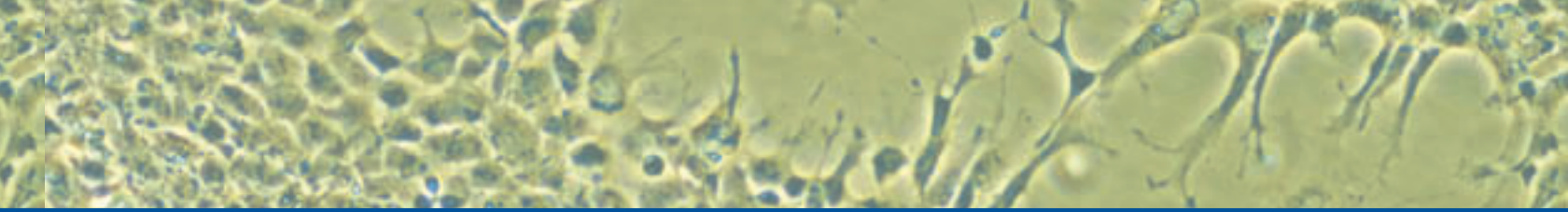

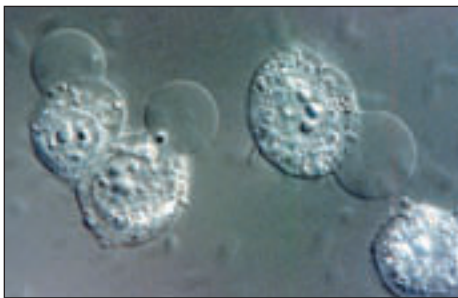

ignore healthy cells) and kill them with a less violent process than VNP. This is illustrated in the photo time sequence on these two pages. 1674 pitted and killed the tumor cells in 15 hours and the dying cells look deflated but did not break

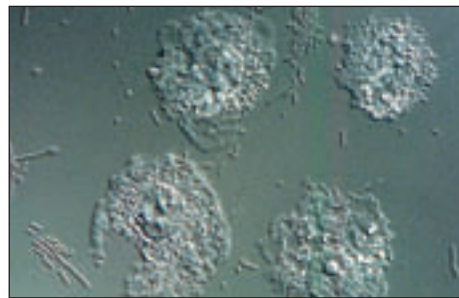
open. VNP20009 killed the prostate tumor cells in 8.5 hours and caused the cells to spill their content which is a strong immune system trigger. While activation of the immune system is desirable in cancer treatment, too zealous

of a response can be disastrous. Thanks to our generous supporters and a lot of hard work, 1674 is well on its way to achieving the delicate balance that will make it a potent yet gentle prostate cancer treatment.

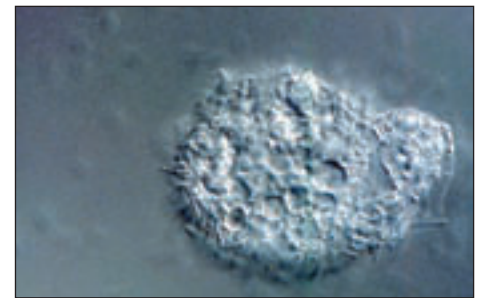
### Cells incubated with CRC's Typhimurium strain 1674

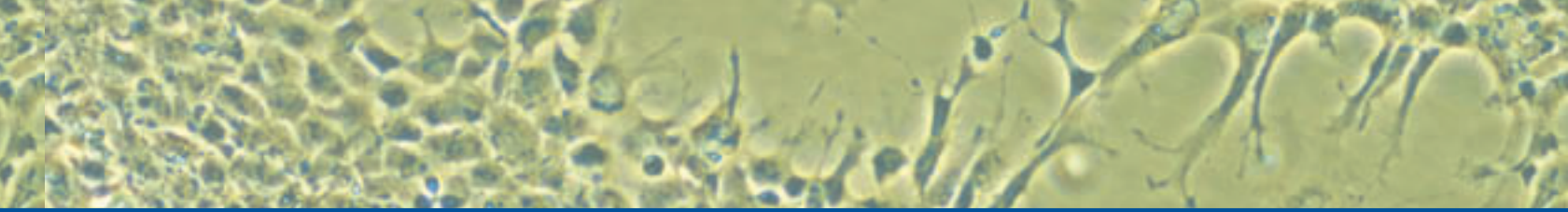
